Approve the Randolph Southern School Corporation 2022-2023 1. school calendar. The calendar was taken into Discussion on December 1, 2021. The calendar aligns with other Randolph County schools, but does not align with the Richmond Area Career Center calendar.

2. Extended Learning Center bids from December 21, 2021

> The school corporation did not receive bids that aligned within our budgetary constraints of \$1,056,443.63. The bids submitted were as follows:

Pridemark Construction=\$2,324,000 with 270 days to complete. Brumbaugh Construction=\$2,388,000 with 365 days to complete. Morton Builders=\$2,750,000 with 390 days to complete.

Superintendent recommends rejecting all three bids. Superintendent recommends breaking the project into subcontacted units for completion utilizing the construction design provided by Lancer+Beebe. The school corporation will bid the envelope package (wall frames, metal roof, metal siding, insulation, and concrete). This package will most likely be over the \$250,000 threshold. Next, the school corporation will sub-contract HVAC, electric, plumbing, flooring, basketball goals and bleachers. Proceeding with the project in this manner will be a tremendous cost savings to the school corporation and allow the project to be completed within the budgetary requirements. However, it will also require hiring a construction manager and much more day-to-day operational work from the administration and maintenance.
