Note from Nurse Owens

The Mobile Dentist will be returning on Tuesday, April 23, 2024. If your student was seen in September, he or she will automatically be placed on the list to be seen in April. Your child must positively identify themselves by answering any two of the following questions: Name, Date of Birth, Phone Number, Address (Street is

Fine), Parent or Guardian Name. If your student cannot answer 2 of those questions, a tag can be made with the student's picture and the identifying information. The student must wear the tag when seeing the dentist. If you have any questions, please contact the office.

Randolph County Promise
