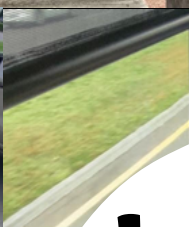

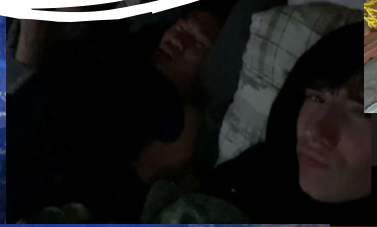

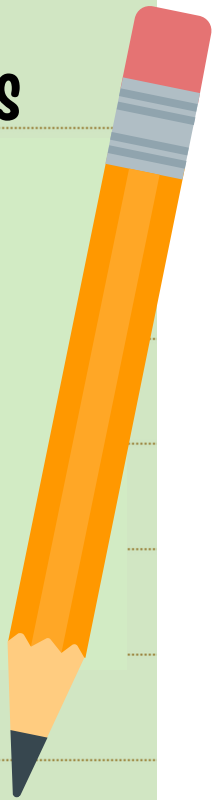
- Varsity Girls track placed third in their invitational on Saturday. They were less than 10 points off of 1st place and the boys placed 6th.
