INDIANA SUN BUCKS

Summer EBT, branded Indiana Sun Bucks is a new and permanent program to provide money to households with school-aged children to purchase food during the summer.

- Households will receive a \$120 lump sum benefit for each qualifying child.
- Children must be eligible for free or reduced-price meals and eligibility must be established annually.
- Students approved for free or reduced meals at any point during the school year qualify for Sun Bucks. Students approved through the Sun Bucks application through the summer also qualify.
- Student is defined as all children enrolled in a school-including pre-k and those older than 18, as long as they were enrolled during the 23-24 school year.
- New cards will be issued for this program.
- Households will receive one card for each eligible student in the household.
- The card will be loaded with the full \$120 benefit.
- The money can be spent on the same items that SNAP dollars can be spent on.
- Households must ensure enrollment information in Final Forms is up-to-date.
- Households already approved for free or reduced benefits during the school year do not need to fill out a Sun Bucks application.
- Households not approved for free or reduced-price benefits should fill out an application with the school to see if they might qualify until May 1st.
- Households who are automatically eligible and those who complete an application by May 1st should receive their card in early June.
- Households may apply using the Sun Bucks application no later than Friday, August 16th to receive benefits for the summer of 2024.
